Guide for recording speeches

using the

Crestron Lecture Capture HD system <u>PLEASE READ INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO USING SPEECH RECORDING EQUIPMENT!</u>

- **#1: Find the USB port on the Laptop Plate at the top of the podium rack**. (It is labled "FOR RECORDING ONLY).
- #2: Insert your USB jump drive into this port. Wait app. 20 seconds until drive begins to pulsate. (This indicates that the drive is now ready for recording.)

#3: Locate the Crestron Touch panel on top of the podium.

(Note: If screen is dark, your hand in close proximity will wake it from sleep mode.) #4: On the touch panel, press the button that says: "Start Here"



Troubleshooting: If this screen appears, click OK, wait an additional 10 seconds, and start again. The recording process takes app. 20 seconds to start. Also, you <u>MUST WAIT</u> until your flash drive stops flashing to remove it from the USB port. The process takes app. 20-30 seconds, after Stop Recording is pressed, to properly save to the drive. Removal before it is ready will prevent it from being successfully saved. To Play back the file, use VLC, which can be downloaded for free from *http://www.videolan.org*
